We offer a range of products and services to our international clients which are summarised below.

Avocado seed

We supply Zutano and/or Bacon seed which is available in August and September each year.

All seed:

- Is guaranteed to be true to type
- Has seed coat removed
- Has been treated for fungal pathogens
- Is stored at ideal temperatures to maximise shelf life
- Is stored in Modified Atmosphere Packaging

Price on application. Minimum order is 2000 seeds.



Scion wood

We can supply a range of scion wood for different cultivars. In addition to the cultivars listed on our website, we have mother trees of other cultivars so please contact us if you are interested in a specific cultivar. Please note that all protected plant material is subject to Licenses. Scion wood is available most of the year.

All scion wood:

- Is guaranteed to be true to type
- Has been treated for fungal pathogens
- Is stored at ideal temperatures to maximise shelf life
- Is stored in Modified Atmosphere Packaging

Price on application. Minimum order is 2000 pieces.



Micro-clones

A micro-clone is a small clonal rootstock plant which has been grafted with its fruiting scion. It is delivered in a one litre pot and will require planting into a larger pot to be grown on in a controlled environment. Full advice is provided.

All micro-clones must be ordered one year prior to delivery.

Please contact us about which scion and rootstock cultivar we can supply as these may vary from country to country. Please note that all protected plant material is subject to Licenses.

Minimum order is 500 plants.



Mini Seedlings

A mini seedling is a small seedling rootstock plant which has been grafted with its fruiting scion. It is delivered in a one litre pot and will require planting into a larger pot to be grown on in a controlled environment. Full advice is provided.

All seedlings must be ordered one year prior to delivery.

Please contact us about which scion and rootstock cultivar we can supply as these may vary from country to country. Please note that all protected plant material is subject to Licenses.

Administration

Lynwood works closely with New Zealand **Ministry of Primary Industries** and their associated verification agencies to meet the phytosanitary certification requirements of importing countries. We also work with international freight forwarding companies to arrange freight and the accompanying documentation.

Services

Lynwood services our international customers in a number of ways.

Consultancy

We consult to multiple nurseries in several countries. This includes:

- nursery infrastructure development
- establishment and implementation of Standard Operating Procedures for all propagation practices and techniques
- hygiene and High Health Scheme advice
- orchard site development
- full orcharding and tree husbandry advice

Joint ventures

Lynwood is involved in several joint ventures with nurseries in different countries. This is very suitable for clients new to avocados, or those wishing to become proficient in the propagation of clonal root stock avocados.

Licencing

Much of the plant material we work with is protected by Plant Breeders Rights (PBRs) or Plant Variety Rights (PVRs). This means it can only be propagated by parties licensed to do so. Lynwood has strong relationships with all the owners of PBRs and PVRs, and so can advocate on client's behalf to become licensed to propagate.

Licenses will only be granted when an application comes via a known and trusted party such as Lynwood.
