In the nursery

The nursery is busy with both clonal and seedling trees in various stages of production. We are currently processing seeds from Zutano fruit ready to be used as nurse seeds for our 2020 trees. Our hardening area is filling up with trees that will be dispatched this spring. This gives the trees time to adjust from being in the greenhouses before being planted.



Hass – Carmen™

Carmen is a type of Hass cultivar which is known for its ability to produce fruit all year round. In New Zealand Carmen can flower out of season in autumn and winter as well (or sometimes instead of) the usual spring flowering. Autumn and winter set fruit is round and looks like autumn set Hass. Carmen trees can be denser than Hass due their ability to flush year round so require careful pruning and management. To date Carmen has only been grown in small numbers in New Zealand. The photos below show a 3 year old Hass-Carmen[™] tree with autumn set fruit. The photo on the left was taken at the end of April and the photo on the right at the beginning of July. Hass-Carmen[™] is available from Lynwood of either seedling or clonal rootstocks.
